

Ioannis Kotsianidis, MD, PhD

Professor of Hematology, Democritus Thrace University, Alexandroupolis, Hellas

Ioannis Kotsianidis was appointed professor in Haematology in 2016. He is the head of the department of Haematology at University Hospital of Alexandroupolis and head of the Laboratory of Haematology and Immunohematology of Democritus university of Thrace, since July 2016. He obtained his medical degree from Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and his PhD degree in Haematology from Democritus University of Thrace. He also worked as a clinical research fellow at the Hammersmith Hospital, Imperial College London. He has a longstanding clinical and scientific experience in Hematology and his work, has a total impact factor >360, > 1700 citations and H-index 21 and is published in some of the top scientific journals in the field of Hematology, Pneumonology and Immunology. He has secured numerous grants during his carrier abroad and in Greece and he was also principal investigator in several clinical trials. Prof. I. Kotsianidis is a member of numerous scientific societies, vice-president of the Hellenic MDS Study Group, vice-president of the Foundation of Hellenic Society of Haematology, member of the Oversight/Advisory committee of International Working Group for Prognosis in MDS (IWG-PM) and member of the steering committee of the EUMDS Registry.
